I wish to thank all that have been helping with the day to day issues and maintenance at the club. Primarily wish to mention 2 areas. First is conserving our energy use by lowering our demand. Second is addressing some of the necessary repairs.

Regarding our energy use, please do your part by insuring that unneeded lights are turned off after use. For those that manage the AC controls, be sure to raise the settings once the period is approaching its completion and then fully return to the minimum setting prior to leaving. Areas that have doorways, such as the kitchen exit and the door to the back area, should be closed as much as possible, and the lights should be turned off when not in use.

On the maintenance side, we have started to correct various items that have been in need of repair and now have a list that we are prioritizing for future repairs. In preparation for this, I would like to reach out to our members, and ask if any of you may know or have direct contact with some dependable and affordable service technicians for various areas of upcoming repairs.
