The following motion was made at the March 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting and will be discussed further (and possibly voted on, I'm not sure) at the April membership meeting:

Motion Title Amend Article IV

Mover: Tony Sellers

I move to amend the ByLaws Article IV, Section 9 by adding language as follows:

## ARTICLE IV - Officers and Duties of Officers

Section 9 The Treasurer shall pay all bills, be custodian of the funds of the organization, shall keep a complete and accurate account of all receipts and disbursements, shall submit a monthly report at the General Membership meeting, and when requested by the President or Board of Trustees, the Treasurer shall advise the Board of Directors in financial matters as able.

All originating checks shall be signed by two (2) of the following:

- 1. President
- 2. First Vice President
- 3. Treasurer

The Treasurer shall report all unauthorized transactions, in conflict with these by-laws, to the Board of Directors and the Membership at the next Membership meeting.

All financial records, receipts and disbursements are Club property.

The President shall appoint and fill vacancies of the Deputy Treasurer with confirmation of the appointment by the Board of Directors. The Deputy Treasurer shall serve a one year term, renewable in the same manner as the original appointment.

The Treasurer shall keep the Deputy Treasurer appraised in all aspects of the position to act in his or her absence or incapacity and may delegate responsibilities thereto. In so much as there is personal liability to the governing bodies, any time the Deputy

Treasurer acts on behalf of the Treasurer they shall be considered 'acting treasurer' and subject to the bookkeeping standards of the organization and state and federal regulations. The Deputy Treasurer shall succeed the Treasurer upon the Treasurer's vacating the office and complete the current term of office until and unless an election is held to elect a Treasurer. The Deputy Treasurer is eligible for election as Treasurer.
