



Original Auerhahn Schuhplattler

The **Schuhplattler** is a traditional style of folk dance popular in the Eastern Alps, originating in Upper Bavaria, Tyrol, and Salzburg. In this dance, the performers stomp, clap, and strike the soles of their shoes (*Schuhe*), thighs, and knees with their hands held flat (*platt*).
